

Dial-A-Ride service & alternative travel options survey

Background

The Dial-A-Ride service is provided by SCA Transport, subsidised by Southampton City Council. The subsidy from the Council ends in September 2024, meaning that the Dial-A-Ride service will be closing at the end of September this year.

The purpose of this survey is to gain feedback from those currently using the service about the potential impact on them of the service ending. As part of this, we want to understand the level of awareness about alternative transport options in the city and how accessible they are.

The feedback will be used to inform our communication with Dial-A-Ride service users while the service closes, and will help ensure everyone potentially impacted is aware of and able to access alternative transport options.
