CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON

BYELAW

BYELAW for the good rule and government of the City of Southampton and for the prevention of nuisances made by the Council of the City in pursuance of Section 235 of the Local Government Act, 1972.

DOGS FOULING FOOTWAYS

1. No person being in charge of a dog shall allow the dog to foul the footway of any street or public place by depositing its excrement thereon.

Provided that a person shall not be liable to be convicted of an offence against this byelaw if he satisfies the Court that the fouling of the footway by the dog was not due to culpable neglect or default on his part.

- 2. For the purposes of this byelaw the owner of the dog shall be deemed to be in charge thereof, unless the Court is satisfied that at the time when the dog fouled the footway it had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person.
- 3. Any person offending against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £20.
- 4. Byelaw 2 of the Byelaws for the Good Rule and Government of the Borough of Southampton and for the prevention of nuisances made by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Southampton at a Meeting of the Council held on 16th October 1935, and confirmed by the Secretary of State on 12th February 1936, is hereby repealed; and for Byelaw 3 of the said Byelaws there shall be substituted:-

PENALTY CLAUSE

"2. Any person offending against the foregoing
Byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction
to a fine not exceeding £2 for every such offence".
