Southampton City Council's Employment Support Team has a new project to support individuals with learning disabilities who want to become more independent. We also provide support to explore paid employment and/or voluntary work in the 'open market of work'. The Employment Support Team are keen to work with any individuals interested in life skills, volunteering and/or employment. Depending on the individual needs of the person we can offer tailored support.

- Increasing confidence & independence
- Initial Information Advice & Guidance (IAG) & getting to know you (GTKY) sessions
- Pre-employment training
- Employability training (tailored to the needs of the group)
- Work clubs
- Supported placements, work experience, job trials, and meaningful activities including volunteering
- Help to access training & education
- Employer engagement to set up placements & employment opportunities
- Support into employment such as job searching, CV creation and interview preparation
- One-to-one support including job coaching and travel training (if required)
- Job Retention support for the individual & employer
- Keeping safe awareness
- Increasing community access
- Money skills
- Promoting health checks
- Exploring telecare solutions
