- 4. The £500 deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom and made payable to The Returning Officer Southampton Parliamentary Constituencies, or by the electronic transfer of funds.
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 12th December 2019.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY, by 12 midnight on **Tuesday 26th November 2019**.
- Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY, by 5 pm on Tuesday 26th November 2019.
- New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY, by 5 pm on Wednesday 4th December 2019.
- Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Centre, Southampton, SO14 7LY, by 5 pm on Thursday 12th December 2019.

To apply on the grounds of physical incapacity, the incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
