BYELAWS

made under Section 68 of the Public Health Act, 1925, as amended by Section 16 of the Restriction of Ribbon Development Act, 1935, by

PARKING PLACES

Interpretation

1. In these Byelaws -

"the Council" means the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Southampton acting by the Council;

"parking place" means a parking place described in the Schedule to these Byelaws;

"driver" means the person who, whether as owner or otherwise, has the charge or control of a vehicle or being present is entitled to give orders to the person having charge or control.

- 2. Where in the Schedule to these Byelaws a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class, the driver shall not permit a vehicle to wait in that parking place unless it is of the specified class.
- 3. A driver shall not permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place at anyone time for longer than the period specified in the Schedule to these Byelaws.
- 4. When a vehicle has left a parking place after waiting thereon the driver shall not within one hour after its leaving permit it to wait again upon that parking place.
- 5. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- 6. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place not being part of a street shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

- 7. The driver of a vehicle while it is waiting in a parking place:-
 - (a) shall not permit the carrying out of any work of construction except such as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the parking place;
 - (b) shall not permit the vehicle to be used for or in connection with the sale of any vehicle or of any other article or the offer of any service for reward.

Penalities

8. Every person who shall offend against any of these Byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding five bounds.
