BYELAWS

Made under Section 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906, by Southampton City Council with respect to the Pleasure Ground known as Weston Common Area, Sholing, Southampton.

- 1. The Series of Byelaws with respect to the Pleasure Ground known as Weston Common Amenity Area, Sholing, Southampton, made by the Council on 3rd October 1975 and confirmed by the Home Office on 10th February 1976 is hereby amended and extended as follows:-
 - (1) 6(ii) shall be deleted and the following provision substituted therefor:-
 - 6(ii) a person shall not, except in the exercise of any lawful right or privilege, ride any bicycle, tricycle or other similar machine in any part of the Pleasure Ground.

Provided that paragraph (ii) of this Byelaw shall not apply to any path, road or track in the Pleasure Ground which by notice conspicuously displayed is designated by the Council as a path, road or track on which cycling is permitted.

(2) These Byelaws may be cited as the City of Southampton Weston Common Amenity Area, Sholing (Amendment) Byelaws 1986.
