We have 3 priorities:

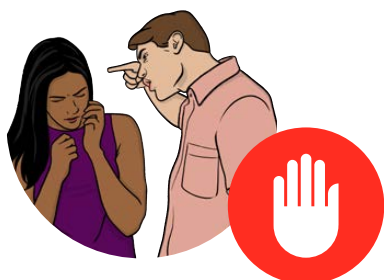


1. Prevention

We want to make sure more people know which adults are at risk of harm and abuse.

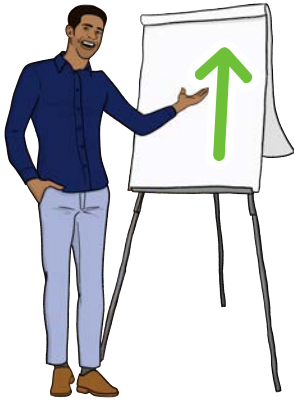


Knowing which adults are at risk means we can stop harm and abuse from happening to them.
