CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON

BYELAW

Made under Section 68 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and Section 171 of the Public Health Act 1875 by Southampton City Council with respect to Hackney Carriages in the City of Southampton.

Byelaw No. 17 with respect to Hackney Carriages made by Southampton City Council on 10th September 1974 and confirmed by one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State on 29th November, 1974, is hereby repealed and replaced by the following byelaw which should be read, and construed as one with the series of Byelaws made by The Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Southampton acting by the Council on 15th June, 1970, and confirmed by one of the said Principal Secretaries of State on 21st September, 1970:-

17 - Provisions fixing the stands of hackney carriages.

Each of the several places specified in the following list shall be a stand for such number of hackney carriages as is specified in the list:-

Above Bar Street - east side, from a point 55 metres south of the junction with Brunswick Place southwards for a distance of 31.5 metres.	7
Bargate Street - north side, from a point 15 metres east of the junction with Portland Terrace eastwards for a distance of 31.5 metres.	7
Bedford Place - west side, from a point 13 metres north of the extended northern kerbline of Waterloo Terrace southwards for a distance of 27 metres	6
Blechynden Terrace - south side, from a point 14 metres east of the extended eastern kerbline of Wyndham Place westwards for a distance of 27 metres	6
Church Street - north-west side, from a point 15 metres north-east of the junction with Shirley High Street north-eastwards for a distance of 13.5 metres and from a point 38.5 metres north-east of the junction with Shirley High Street north eastwards for a distance of 4.5 metres	4
