A Use of Resources review was undertaken on 8 January 2019 and a well led review on 22, 23 and 24 January 2019 with another unannounced inspection in urgent and emergency care.</p>		
4.	<p>The CQC inspection report is due to be published shortly. If it is published prior to the HOSP meeting the report will be circulated to the Panel and made available at the meeting to enable members to discuss the findings with representatives from the NHS Trust.</p>
