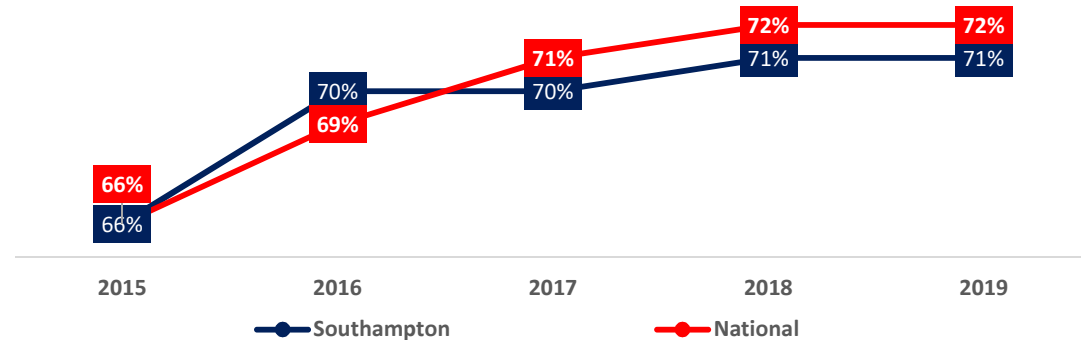


## 2019 Early Years Foundation Stage – Provisional Results

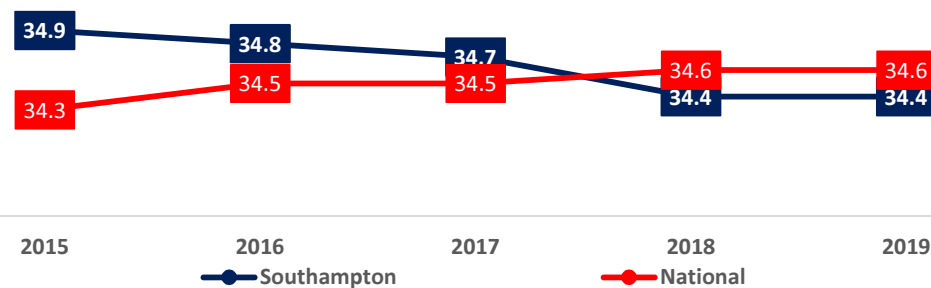
2019 Southampton EYFS performance is broadly in line with the National average

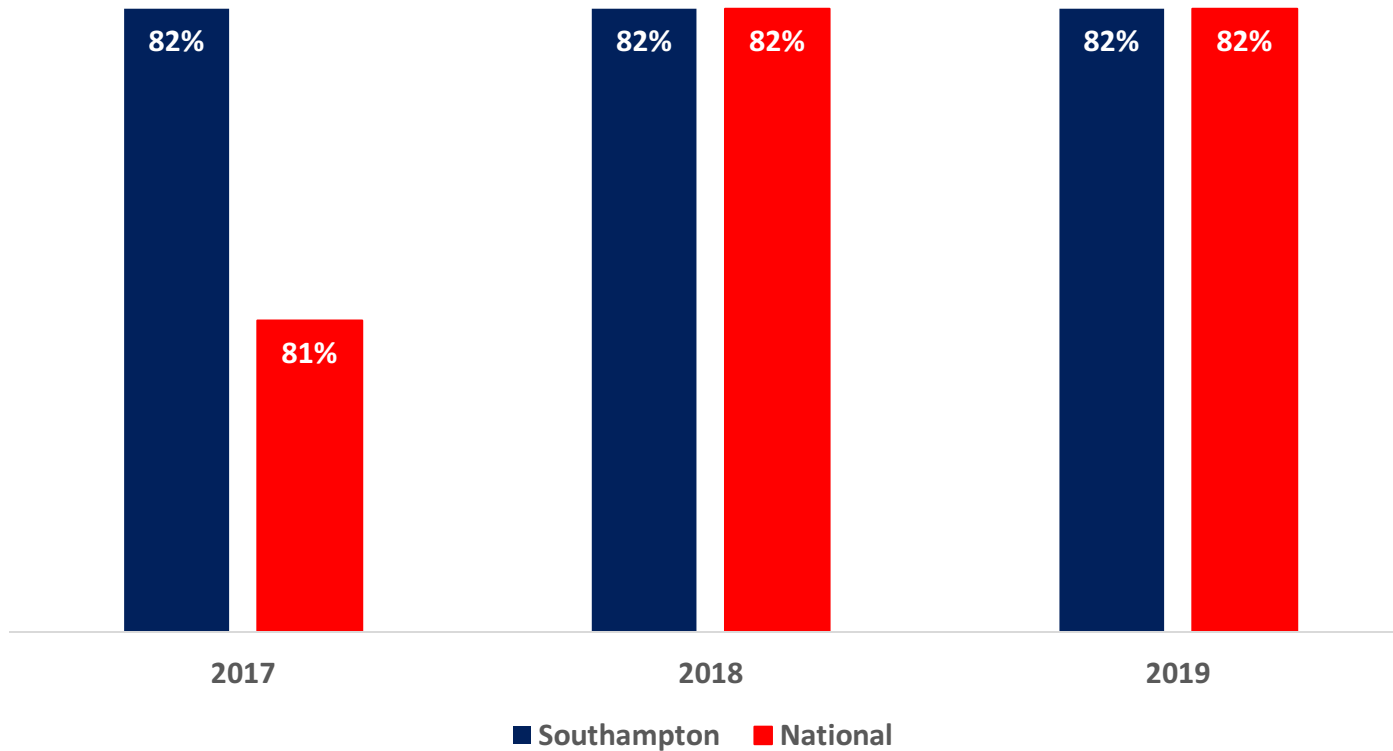

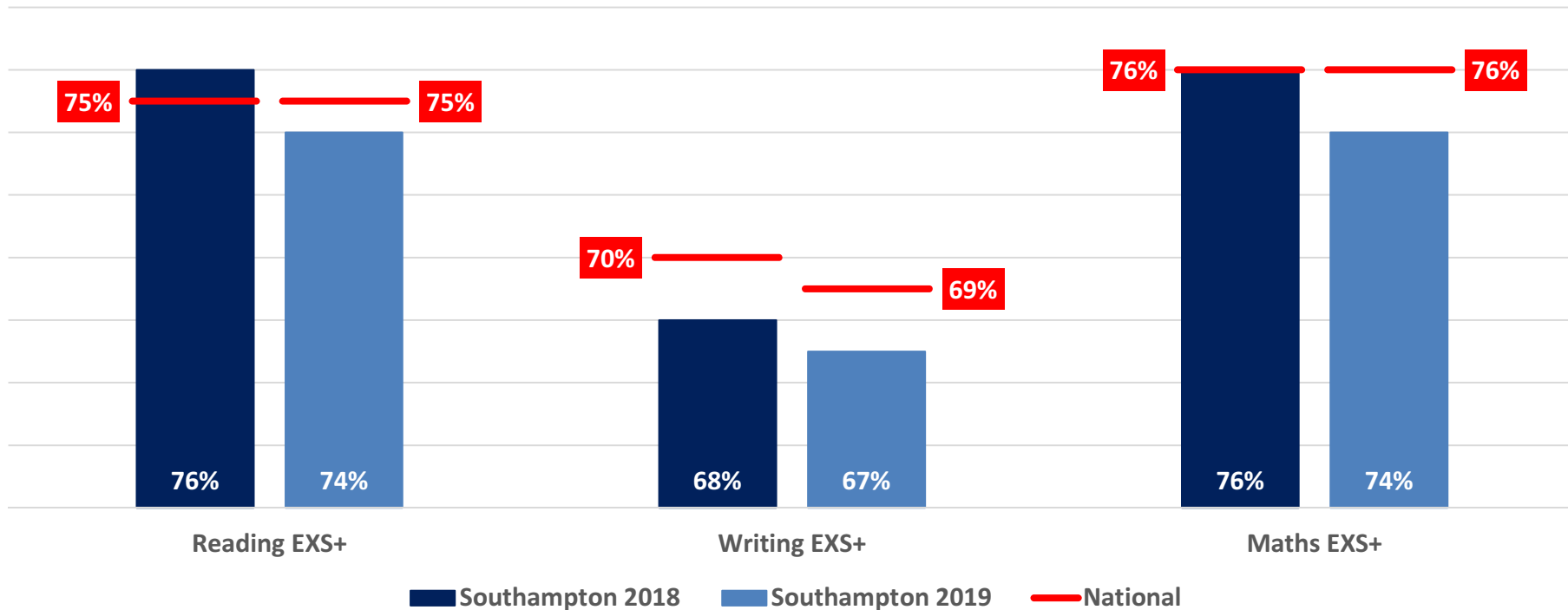
## 2019 Year 1 Phonics – Provisional Results

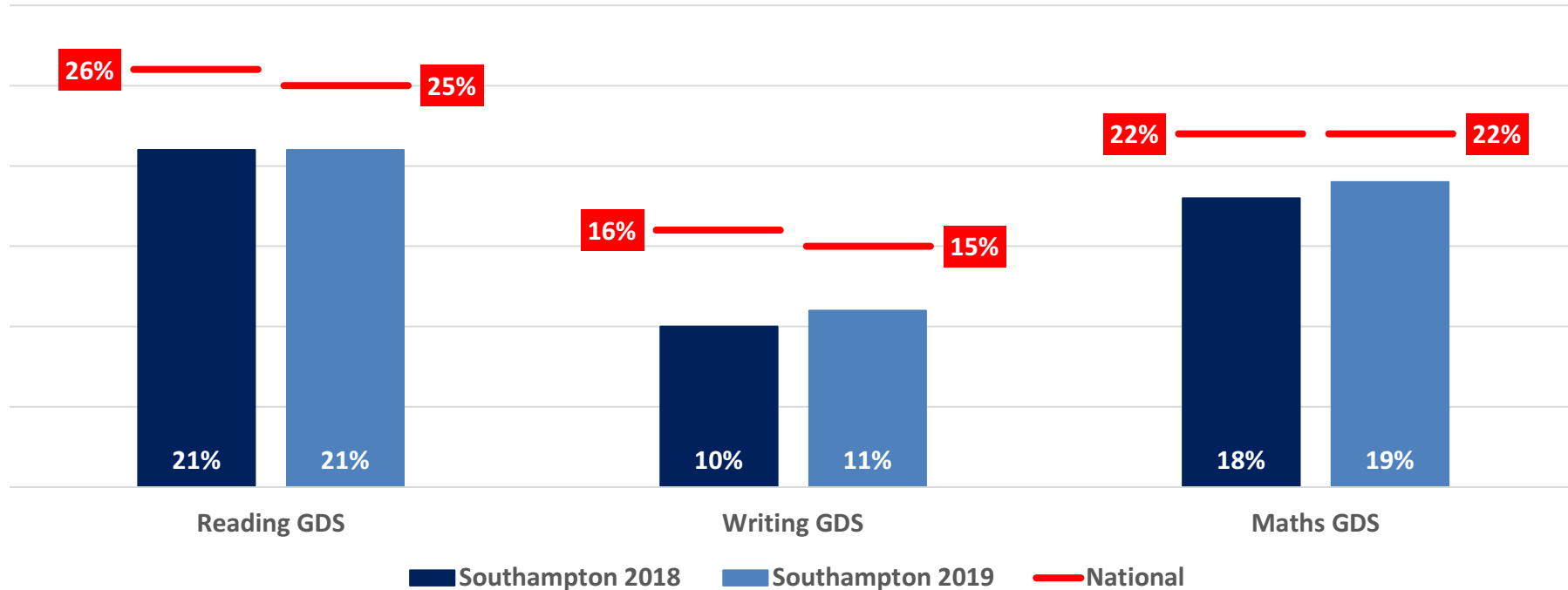
Key Stage 1 - % achieving the Expected Standard

**Southampton Key Stage 1 outcomes at the Greater Depth continue to be below the National average**

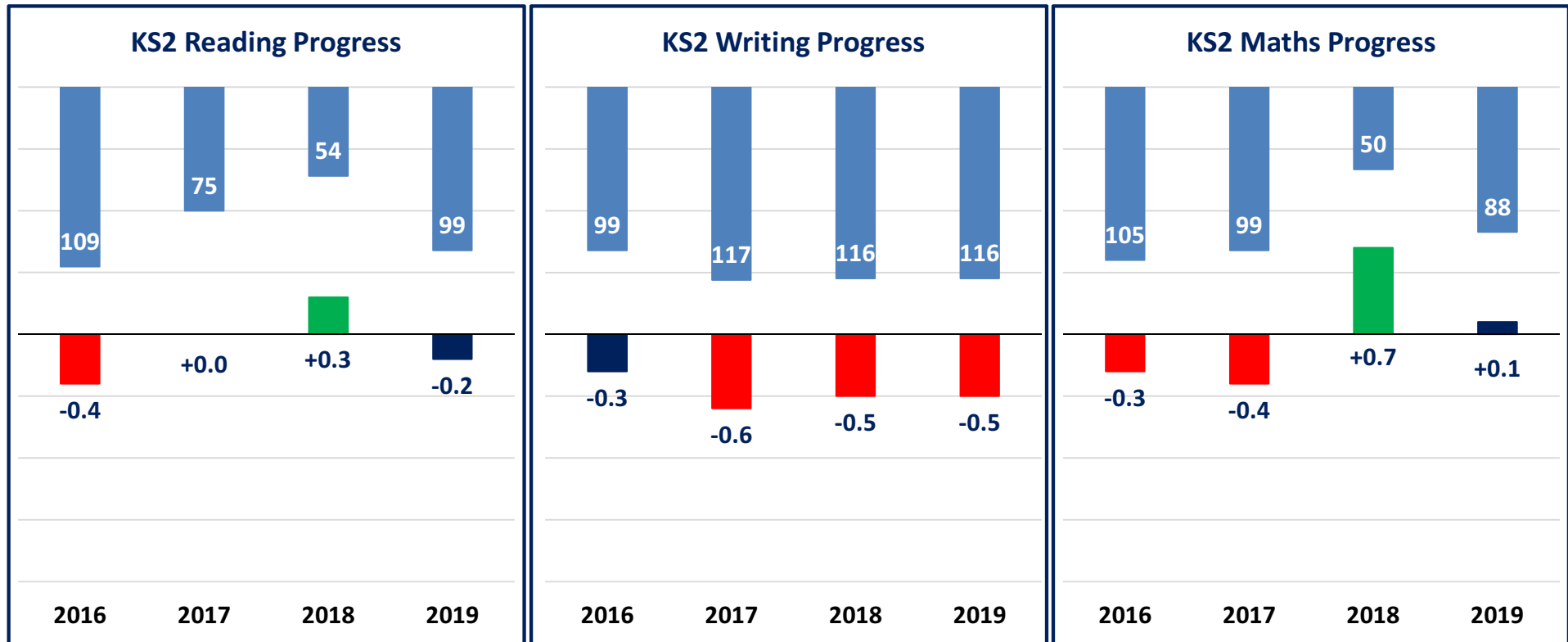

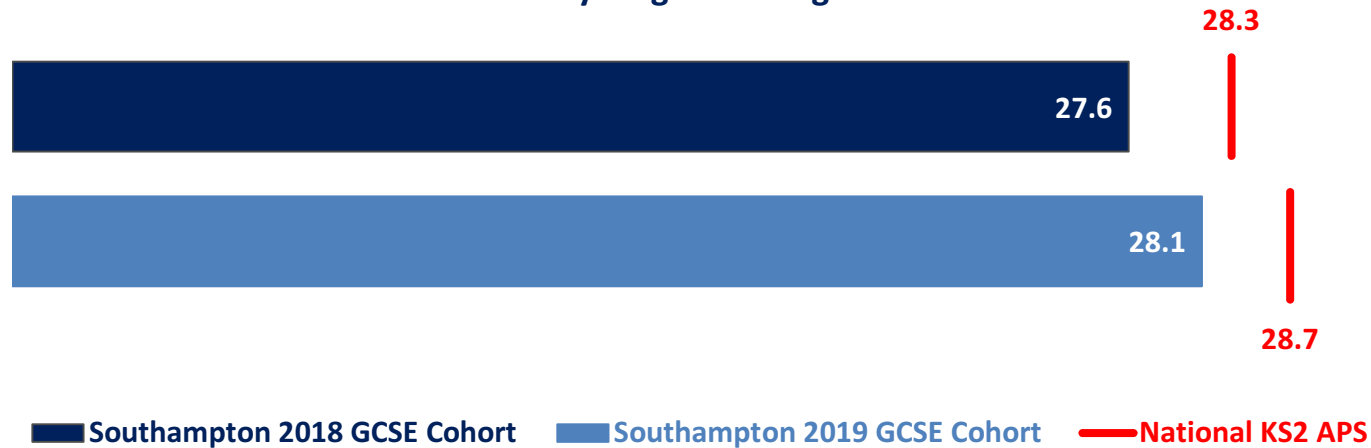

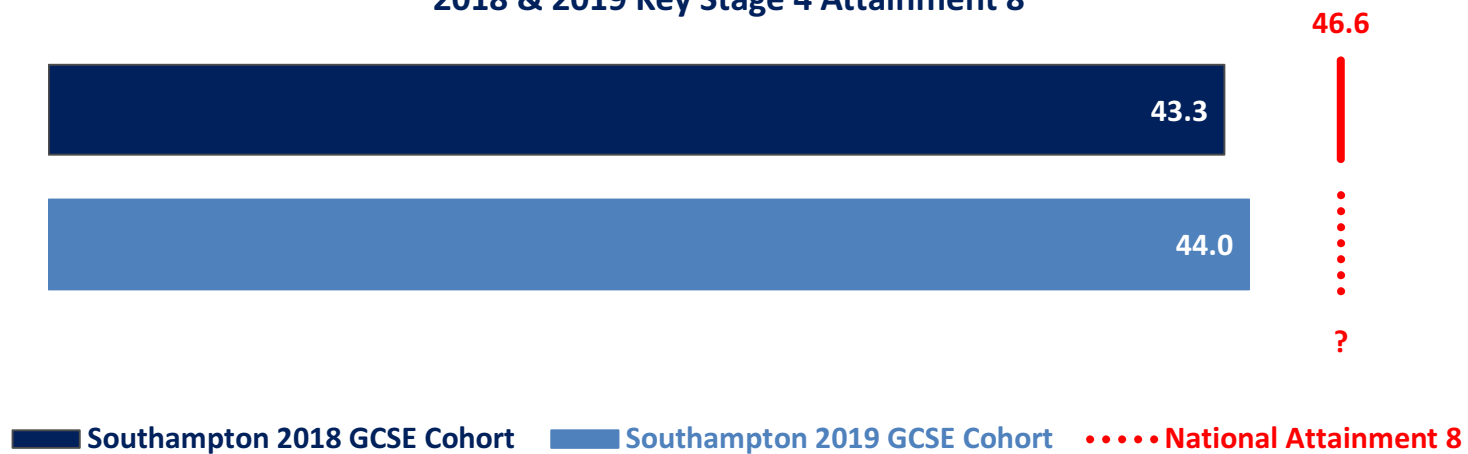

## Key Stage 4 Provisional Results - Progress

As yet, no official DfE Progress Scores have been published

However, eight of the twelve secondary school participated in the FFT Early Results Project

Using these provisional progress scores and *estimating* the Progress 8 scores for the remaining schools, we *estimate* that the 2019 Progress 8 score *may* fall between the range of -0.25 and -0.20 for the Local Authority overall.

The 2018 Progress 8 score for Southampton was -0.22, with a ranking of 124<sup>th</sup> out of 152 Local Authorities nationally.

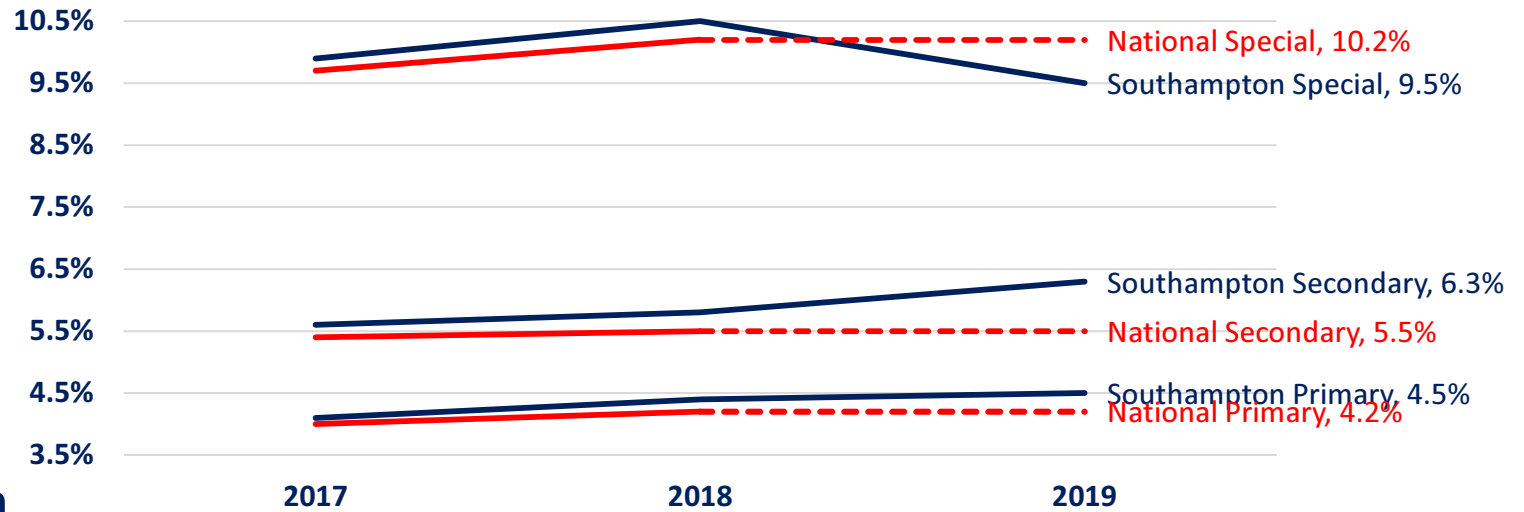

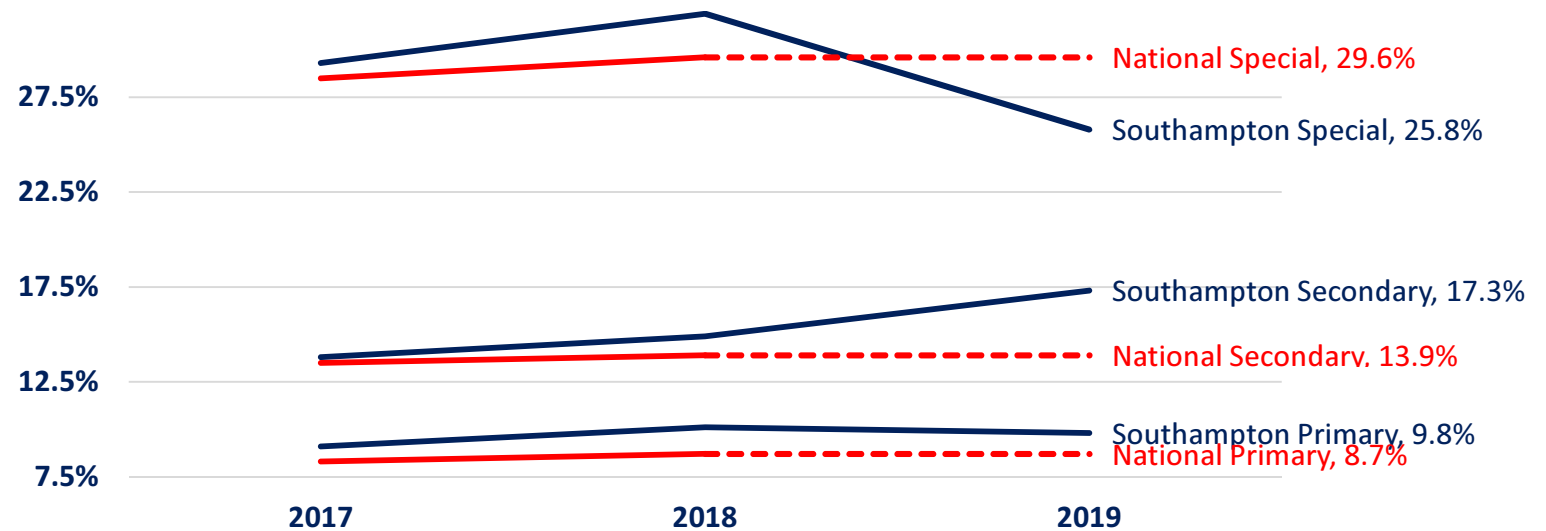

<b>Phonics</b>	Outcome remains steady and in-line with a stable National average
<b>Key Stage 1</b>	<p>A regression in Expected Standard+ threshold outcomes relative to National across all of Reading, Writing &amp; Maths resulting in performance below the National average</p> <p>Continued Greater Depth threshold outcomes below National across all of Reading, Writing &amp; Maths</p>
<b>Key Stage 2</b>	<p>Overall KS2 attainment below National for the first time in seven years</p> <p>Regression in Reading &amp; Maths progress although in-line with National. Progress in Writing significantly below National for the third consecutive year</p>
<b>Primary Phase</b>	Challenges remain around attainment in Writing at the higher threshold
<b>Key Stage 4</b>	Improved attainment in 2019 from a more able cohort. 2019 progress predicted to be broadly similar to that in 2018.
<b>Key Stage 5</b>	A-Level threshold outcomes improved but below the National average

### Southampton Overall Absence Trend

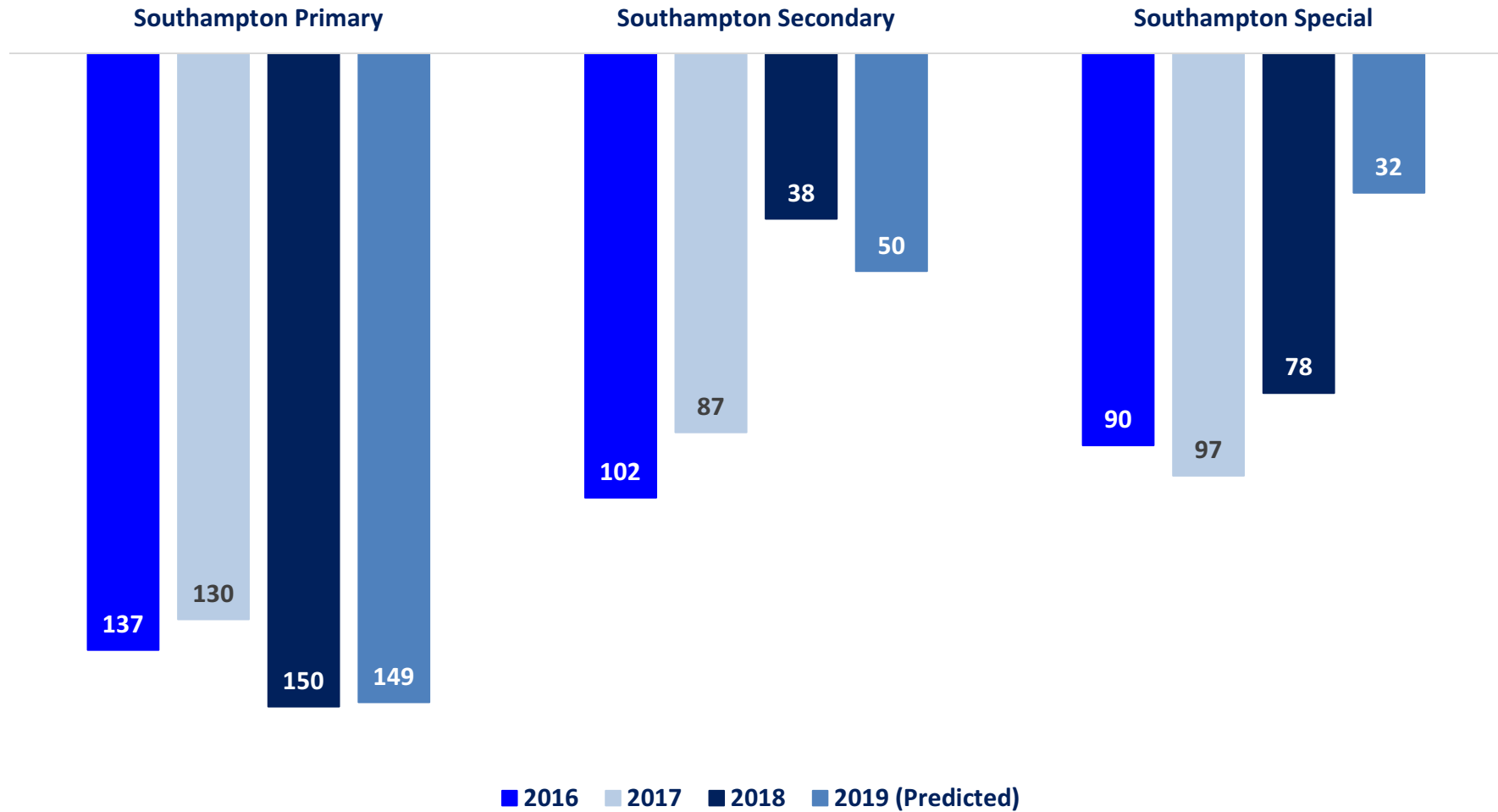


### Southampton Persistent Absence Trend
