Overall, there were 130 respondents.



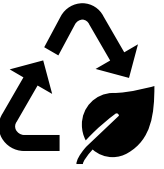

Priorities in the Home

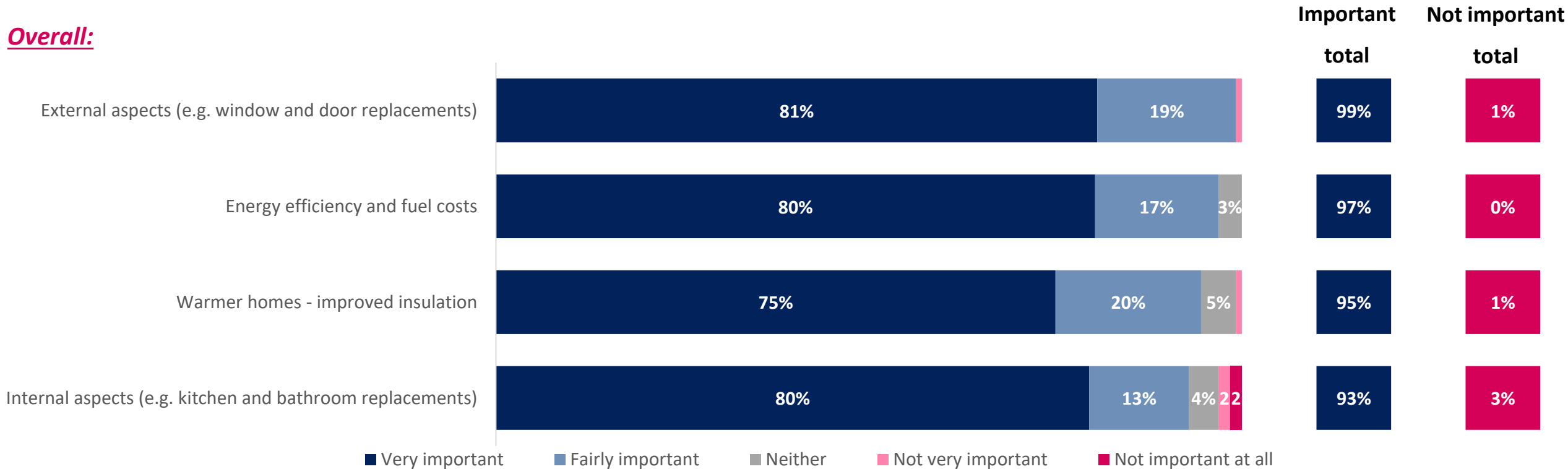
- Key findings:**
- External aspects such as window and door replacements appear to be the most important aspects to tenants (99%)
 - Internal aspects such as kitchen and bathroom replacements appear to be the least important aspects in the home, in comparison (93%)

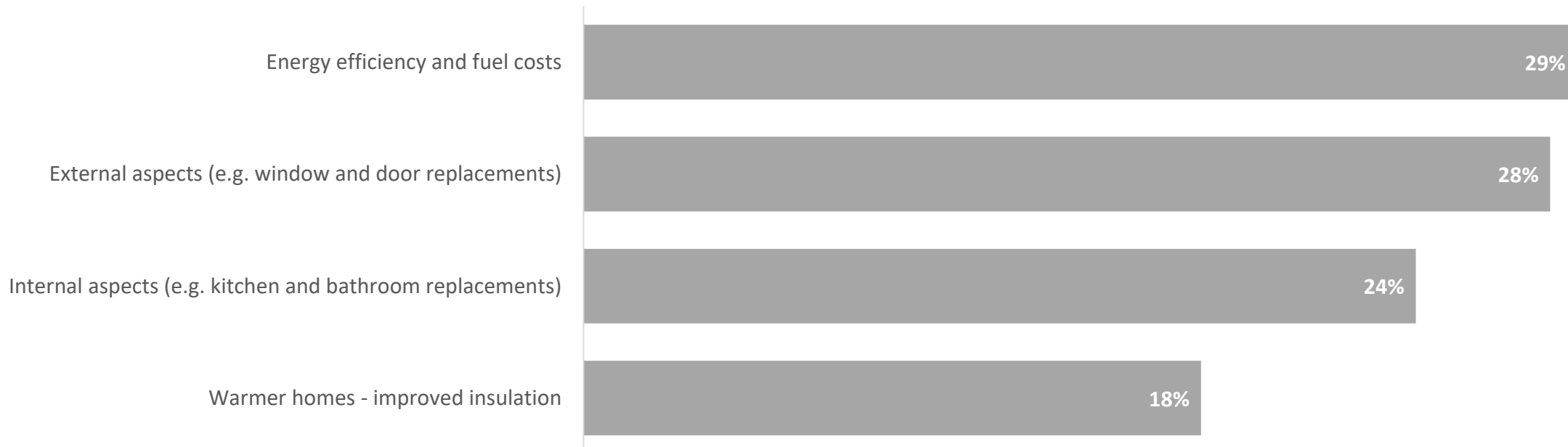
- Energy efficiency and fuel costs appears to be the most selected priority in the home (29%)
- The least selected priority in the home was warmer homes, including improved insulation (18%)

Which aspect would you prioritise out of the following options?

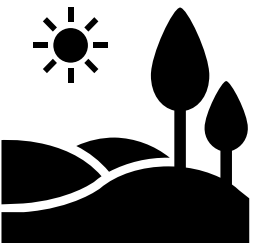

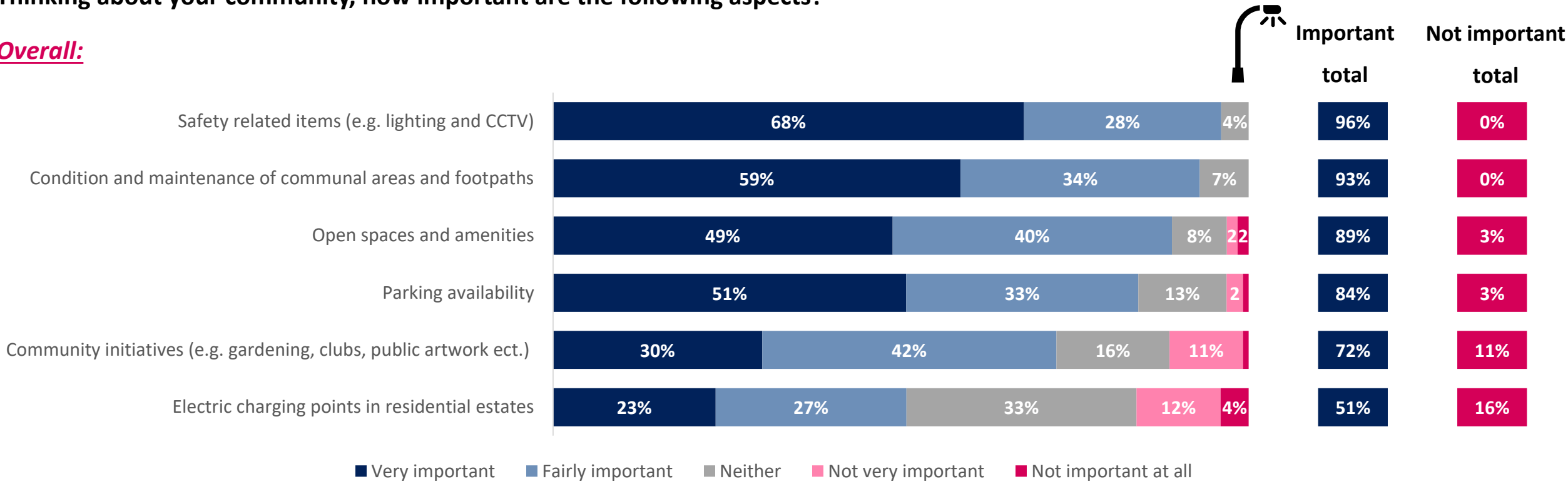
Key findings:

- Safety related items, such as lighting and CCTV appear to be the most important aspect within the community (96%)
- Just over half the respondents selected that electric charging points in residential estates are important in the community
