This Order may be cited as "**the City of Southampton (Winchester Road)(No.2) Air Quality Management Area (Number Three) Order 2008**" and shall come into effect on 2008.

The area edged in red on map, Air Quality Management Area (3) is to be designated as an air quality management area (the designated area). The designated area incorporates the area described in Schedule One and more particularly delineated on the map, Air Quality Management Area (3).

HIGHWAY	JUNCTION/ADJOINING ROAD
Winchester Road	From the roundabout where Winchester Road, Hill Lane, and Burgess Road meet extending along Winchester Road and ceasing before the junction with Ashwood Gardens including the surrounding land and properties as more particularly delineated on the map comprising part of this order.

HIGHWAY	JUNCTION/ADJOININGROAD
A33 Town Quay/Platform Road/Canute Road	From the West Gate Roundabout (the junction with West Quay Road, Western Esplanade, Herbert Walker Avenue and Town Quay Road) and ceasing at the junction of Canute Road and Royal Crescent including the surrounding land and properties as more particularly delineated on the map comprising part of this order.
Terminus Terrace	From its junction with Platform Road and ceasing at the junction with Bernard Street including the surrounding land and properties as more particularly delineated on the map comprising part of this order.
