## **DECISION DETAILS/DESCRIPTION**

To consider the report of the Cabinet Member for Health and Adult Social Care detailing recommendations following the review of the Health and Wellbeing Board. The Health and Wellbeing Act 2012 requires Health and Wellbeing Boards, formed of key leaders from the health and care system, to work together to improve the health and wellbeing of their local population and reduce health inequalities.
