The "financial affairs or business affairs" include past, present and contemplated activities.

Information relating to any consultations or negotiations, or contemplated consultations or negotiations, in connection with any labour relations matter arising between the Authority or a Minister of the Crown and employees of, or office holders under, the Authority.	"Employee" means a person employed under a contract of service with the Council and would not therefore include a consultant or a temporary member of staff employed through an agency or a company. Information about such a person, however, may well be covered under the exemptions in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 but it will depend on the individual matter.
		"Labour relations matter" means matters which may be the subject of a trade dispute within the meaning of Section 218(1) of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 or any dispute about such a trade dispute. # **CHILDREN'S SOCIAL CARE PORTFOLIO**

Title

Establishment of an in house Edge of Care Service

Details

To consider the report of the Cabinet Member for Children's Social Care seeking approval to establish an Edge of Care Service in house identified as a key transformation driver in reducing the numbers of children coming into care in the city and reducing the significant cost pressure to the Council. The new service will aim to reduce the need for children and young people to be looked after, by either working with families to keep children safely at home or by keeping care placements short and reuniting children and young people with their families as soon as possible.

This proposal supersedes a previous proposal to commission an Edge of Care service from an external provider using a Social Impact Bond (SIB) model which was developed as part of the Big Lottery's Commissioning for Better Outcomes Programme. A procurement for this service failed to yield a bid capable of delivering the service to the quality required and so officers have reviewed the options available to the Council for establishing this service.

Further to detailed work up and appraisal of the options, developing this service in house is believed to be the optimum and most cost effective way of achieving the outcomes required. Full details of this proposal and option appraisal will be included in the Cabinet report.
